

Checklist for Landscapers and Nurseries for successfully bringing Hemlock stock into NH

- 1. Call NH Dept of Agriculture, M & F (NHDAMF) to make sure the grower is not in a quarantined (infested) county and is thus eligible to ship hemlocks into NH.

- 2. Call the grower to inform them of the requirements of the new quarantine, particularly sections (VII) and fax a copy to them if necessary.

- 3. Obtain a copy of the State Phytosanitary report issued to the grower and make sure a copy is faxed to NHDAMF prior to stock being shipped into NH.

- 4. When stock arrives in NH, isolate the stock from any other hemlock shipments. It would be in your best interest to keep shipments separate even after the NHDAMF inspection.

- 5. Notify NHDAMF that the shipment has arrived and to arrange for an inspection.

- 6. Separate and stand up the hemlock trees so that a NHDAMF inspector can inspect all sides of the trees.

- 7. Maintain a record of sale for all hemlocks sold, and inform resellers that they must keep records as well. NHDAMF must be able to track trees to their final planted location.
