## NHDAMF Organic Certification Program Surrender of Organic Certificate Form

As a certified organic producer, you are required to annually submit an updated organic system plan (renewal application), and pay the annual certification and inspection fees (National Organic Program (NOP) Regulations, *Section 205.406 <u>Continuation of certification</u>).* 

If you choose not to renew your current certification, and want to avoid receiving any certification suspension or revocation notices, then you need to *surrender* your organic certificate by notifying this office in writing (NOP Section 205.404(c) <u>Granting certification</u>).

To officially surrender your organic certificate, please read the below statement, and submit the requested information, include your signature where indicated, and return the form by mail or fax to:
