EAB Quarantine Summary Sheet

Regulated articles within the quarantine area shall be processed by:

- Removal of bark and an additional ½” of wood; or
- Kiln sterilization treatment (for wood up to 3” in width) as per T404-b-1; or
- Heat treatment to 60°C for 60 minutes as per T314-a; or
- Chipping materials to a size of 1” or less in two dimensions;

October 1 – April 30

Regulated Articles Moving Outside of a Quarantined Area

Movement of non-processed materials can only move to facilities that possess a Compliance Agreement during the Non-Flight Season (October 1 - April 30).

May 1 - September 30

Regulated Articles Moving into a Non-Quarantined Area

Regulated articles must be processed as described above during the Flight Season (May 1 - September 30) before being moved outside of the quarantined area.

Facilities Under a Compliance Agreement Must Abide by the Following:

- Physical separation of all regulated materials from other ash wood materials until processed; and
- Waste material must be chipped or shredded to a size of 1” or less in any two dimensions and/or burned on site; and
- Processing or disposal of material must occur during the EAB Non-Flight period (October 1 – April 30). *Any Unprocessed Material remaining after the Non-Flight period shall be considered a violation.*
- Renew their Compliance Agreements yearly.

Movement of Regulated Articles through a Quarantined Area

Regulated articles originating outside of a quarantine area may move through a quarantine area only if the following requirements are met:

- Regulated articles shall be safeguarded as to prevent the potential infestation from EAB while in transit; and
- The point of origin must be documented.

Movement of Regulated Articles Into a Quarantined Area

Regulated articles moved into a quarantine area shall meet all requirements listed above.
