

Continuing Education

Continuing Education (CE) programs used to meet requirements for veterinary license renewal must be approved by the New Hampshire Board of Veterinary Medicine. Programs must pertain to veterinary medicine and surgery and be scientific in nature. A maximum of 25% of credits may be obtained from compendium and/or approved online programs. A maximum of 25% of credits may also be obtained in alternative medicine, but programs must be RACE or RAIVE approved. Practice management programs are not approved to meet CE requirements.
